

**WILMAR SCHOLARSHIP**

**The Scholarship:** The **WILMAR Scholarship** was established to recognize the service, contributions and sacrifice that military and other safety forces members make to the locations in which they serve and to their families. The All Saints Endowment Board will review applications and annually award this scholarship. This scholarship is open to All Saints School students who are **enrolled in 1<sup>st</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> grade during the '21-'22 school year**. There will be one (1) **\$1,000 recipient** selected for this scholarship.

**Criteria:** Applicants for this scholarship must have an **immediate** family member (**mother, father, step-mother, step-father**) who is an **active** member in one of the following military or safety forces: military (all branches), police, fire or paramedics/EMS.

**Process:** Students may be nominated by anyone. The nominated student, parent of nominated student or other person nominating the student may complete the attached application (except the essay). All nominated students may receive assistance for organizing their thoughts to complete the essay requirement of this scholarship application. However, nominated students in 4<sup>th</sup> grade and above are expected to complete the essay requirement in their own writing.

Applications must be returned in an envelope to All Saints School (Office) or the St. John Vianney Parish Office - to the attention of The All Saints Endowment Board - **BY NO LATER THAN Friday, January 14, 2022**

The applications will be reviewed by at least a 3-person subset of current, non-school parent members of the All Saints Endowment Board.

The recipient of this scholarship will be announced at the Catholic Schools Week Mass at St. John Vianney on Saturday, **January 29, 2022 at 6:00 PM.**
