The St. Ignatius of Loyola scholarship was established in 2022 to recognize a student who has shown extraordinary motivational and personal growth in core academic courses. The focus of this scholarship wishes to reward that student whose perseverance and dedication to their academia is uniquely demonstrated. This scholarship is open to All Saints of St. John Vianney Students who are enrolled in 5th through 7th grade during the ‘22-’23 school year. The scholarship funds awarded will be applied to the **‘23-’24 school year**. There will be one (1) \$1,000 recipient selected for this scholarship.

Criteria: Applicants for this scholarship must be current students in 5th through 7th grade.

Process: Students may only be nominated by a teacher or staff member of All Saints of St. John Vianney School. The person nominating the student must complete the attached application. Applications must be returned to the All Saints School Office by no later than **Friday, January 13, 2023**. Applications will be reviewed by the founders of the scholarship.

The winning recipient of this scholarship shall remain private and no announcement will be made at any ceremony. The winner of this scholarship will be notified of their selection by the principal and/or pastor of All Saints of St. John Vianney during Catholic Schools week.
